Students identified each spring will be provided an opportunity to improve basic skills, further their academic progress, and/or make-up credits in areas and subjects where work has not met standards.

Elementary (K – 6) students

- Student not meeting grade expectations at the students' grade level

Junior High (7 – 8) students

- Any student who fails one of the core academic classes (math, science, English, social studies)
- Student who needs a class to be promoted to the next grade level

Senior High (9 – 12) students

- Any 9th and 10th grade student failing a required class
- Any student needing remediation to pass an MCA II test
- High school students will be able to take two courses for credit during summer school
