Brown County Public Health has **2** COVID 19 Vaccination Clinic scheduled for next week – in  
New Ulm - **Please share with family and friends**

### **MAKE AN APPOINTMENT AT LINK BELOW**

The clinic scheduled for May 21<sup>st</sup> is Moderna vaccine and open to the public for age 18 and  
above.

The clinic scheduled for May 22<sup>nd</sup> is Pfizer vaccine and open to the public ages 12 years of age  
and older.

For those who are 18 years of age and younger, a parent must be present at the time of  
vaccination.

This is by appointment only – **see link below – NO WALK INS**

It will be first come first serve.

**VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION – please read in its entirety**

***Attached:***

- ***Consent form – please print and complete if you have access to a printer - If you are unable to print we will have some at the clinic for you to complete.***
- ***Fact sheet related to the vaccine that you signed up for.***
- ***Information about what to expect at the clinic when you arrive, arrival instructions.***
  - ***We ask that you complete the consent and bring it with you when you come if you are able to.***
  - ***Please read the appropriate fact sheet and the information about what to expect and arrival information in its entirety . This is critical so we can vaccinate everyone efficiently.***
  - ***Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to your scheduled appointment time- we will be taking people in order unless they are late.***
  
- ***DO NOT register for an appointment for a Moderna or Pfizer vaccine clinic if you already know for sure you would be unavailable for your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. You need to be available that day for the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose unless you are sick or quarantined. Moderna vaccine 2<sup>nd</sup> dose will be exactly 4 weeks from the date you get your 1<sup>st</sup> dose, Pfizer vaccine 2<sup>nd</sup> dose will be exactly 3 weeks from the date you get your 1<sup>st</sup> dose.***

***Contraindications to Getting COVID 19 Vaccine - please do not register if you are in any of these categories***

- ***If you are in your 10 days of isolation because you have COVID 19 you are not eligible until after those 10 days are complete – not until day 11***
- ***If you are in quarantine – 14 days– you cannot get the vaccine until that quarantine period is complete and you have NO symptoms and have tested negative towards the end of your quarantine period***
- ***If you have had ANY other vaccine in the 14 days prior to your scheduled COVID 19 vaccination***
- ***If you have had monoclonal antibody therapy (BAM) for COVID 19 illness in the last 90 days***
