Building reports

- Tim reported on 6 month inspection that was done
- Doug reported G & R controls were working better and were easy to operate the AC in HS gym
- Amanda shared the 10 year facility plan

Old Business

- The STEM project received considerable discussion as where would be the best location in order to get it started
 - One option was to move Sydney to 201 and Jeanine to 134
 - A second option was to use the commons
 - Move the ECSE equipment and adaptative things to the old band room
 - Question on how much the FACS room was scheduled

Door replacement – High school building will have 46 solid oak doors with a vent for air exchange (\$31,653); the NW gym doors will also have metal doors (\$3,600); magnetic strips do not work

Old lawnmower – four bids and sold to Dave Haala

Ball Diamonds had bleachers added with the donation from Amundson's; cement was added underneath as well as at the JV diamond

Surplus desks (140 Ele, 70 HS0 and 3 warmer ovens to give away or sell)

New business

Security cameras are fine but need to update the hardware. Possibly look at a web based system.

Tracking for stage curtains is wearing out making them difficult to open and close. Add to the schedule for replacement for about \$30,000.

No asbestos removal next year making those funds available for something else.

Additions for the outside batting cages would be adding 8-16' poles for about \$1,000. S & J would cement them in.

Boys locker room upgrades were discussed with the best solution moving it to ground level.

Hand washing area needed in the outside concession stand. \$75 a month to rent a portable one.
