October 8, 2018

Meeting called to order at 3:35 p.m. Minutes from the April meeting were accepted.

Building reports

- John C concerned about elementary gym HVAC; April quote for the roof was \$80,000. A walk to school committee has been meeting monthly. The crossing light over highway 4 has not been working. MDOT suggest a flashing light similar to what is on 1st Ave and Highway 14 and split the cost with the city. Quote is \$11,000 with free installation and the city would own it and maintain it.
- Shane reported the temperatures better in the high school building. Need to spray for bugs before school starts.
- Doug indicated there have been lots of issues with HVAC including wet floor in the cafeteria. Things were not installed properly in the ag shop. Sieman hadn't labeled things so it is hard to track and find source of problem
- A compressor went out and costs \$11,000 to replace the unit. Will be back over MEA break to repair. Filters are changed four times a year.
- Tim reported that asbestos removal is mostly pipe wrapping in the basement. He suggested changing chemical for cleaning.
- Amanda presented financials for the various funds.

Old Business

- LED lights have been installed and are brighter plus the custodians can change them.
- The plan is to get away from carpet and go with tile in classrooms.
- Will be cutting back on the number of coats of wax – hallways 8, classrooms 6
- The Stem room is in the former commons area.

New Business

- A grant was applied for to create a vestibule entryway and have the elementary and HS doors inside. Kids could then wait inside.
- Update the banners in the High School Gym
- The parking lot quote is \$125,000 from M & R to tear everything out and start over.
- Is there a fund to repair band instruments or a plan for replacement of the school owned equipment?
